If your school is interested in attending a Meet the Artists performance, please read the following carefully, fill out the registration form and submit it by mail or electronically.

1. REGISTRATION FORMS: All programs are subject to change. Fully complete all sections of the form with as much detail as possible. Registrations will not be taken over the phone; all phone registrants will be directed to the website. Forms are also available online at AlysStephens.org/Connect

2. RESERVATIONS AND SEATING: Reservations will be made on a first come, first-served basis. Reservations will be confirmed via email. Any change in registration numbers needs to be emailed to ArtPlay@uab.edu. Seating assignments are based on age and special needs of students.

To accommodate all patrons we reserve the right to determine seating arrangements. Bus drivers are welcome to join the audience and will need to be included in the total head count.

3. BUS SCHOLARSHIPS: Bus scholarships are available to schools with demonstrated economic need. Awards are based on a number of factors, including the percentage of students on free/reduced lunches and the number and geographic distribution of requests received. Requests will be considered on a first come, first served basis. All inquiries must include the name of your school, the percentage of students on free/reduced lunches and the jurisdiction your school falls under (Jefferson County, Shelby County, Birmingham City, etc.). Bus scholarships will be issued upon receipt of complete evaluation and invoice from your school corporation, due no later than two weeks following a performance. Please email a copy of your invoice to ArtPlay@uab.edu and include the name of the school, grade, show attended, mailing address of school/corporation, and a breakdown of charges (driver, fuel, etc.).

4. ARRIVAL/PARKING: Please plan on arriving at the Alys Stephens Center 15 minutes before the show begins. If you realize you will be late, please contact ArtPlay at 205 975 7469 as soon as possible. Parking instructions will be given at the time of arrival. Please have all bus drivers provide a contact number where they can be reached during a performance in the event a bus may need to be moved prior to dismissal.

5. CANCELLATION POLICY: In the case of school delays/closings due to inclement weather or special circumstances, we may attempt to adjust a performance time or cancel a show altogether. If your school needs to cancel, you must let us know as soon as you are able. Failure to show up after confirmed registration may lead to your school being taken off the list for future shows.
